What is the Ski Challenge? Serious Fun!

The Ski Challenge organizes recreational skiers into race leagues, similar to tennis, golf or bowling. Each league has 10-16 teams with ten members per team. The league series includes seven weeks of racing.

Members race through two, timed modified giant slalom courses. A handicapping system compares each racer's individual time to a pacesetter's on the same run to determine a new handicap. The better of the two handicapped runs is used for scoring.

No previous experience is necessary, only the desire to have fun! The timed courses are on hills designed for intermediate skiers.

How to Join



Anyone may join the leagues as an individual, with a few friends, or start a new team (on a space available basis). Members join a league and race in that league (same day & area) for the entire seven week series. You may join more than one league, but may only race on one team per league. Kids are welcome to participate in any of the family or all age leagues. Adults 18 and over may participate in the Adult leagues. Team Points & Awards

Members make one run in each course to determine their handicap. The top six out of 10 racers count for the team's points. These six may vary from week to week. If there is a tie, the 7th, 8th, and 9th racers' scores may be used. Points accumulate each week for team standings in leagues. Each person is ranked individually in his or her age group each week using the best handicap of that week averaged with past handicaps. Individual handicaps are used to determine which division the team races in at the State Championships at the end of the season.

Recognition is given to the most improved and fastest skiers at each league event. Every skier will earn a medal at each event. Every member has the chance to win door prizes donated by sponsors at every event. The weekly result newsletter lists individual rankings by age as well as team standings. Results can also be found on the web site.

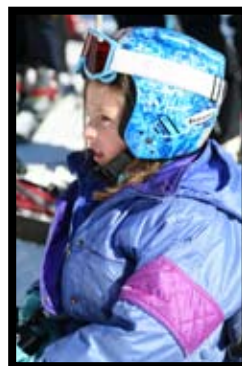
All handicaps are sent in to NASTAR for national ranking.

Can Kids Participate?

Yes! Children 4-17 may join the Buck Hill Saturday and Friday all age, Wild Mountain Sunday PM and Friday all age, and the Hyland Tuesday all leagues. On the all age leagues a parent is not require to race and adults and kids can either be separate or on the same teams. A parent needs to sign a liability release form prior to participation.

There is no formal coaching with this program, however, there will be Ski Challenge staff members at the starting ramp to help the kids get started.

All these leagues run for seven weeks and the fee is \$110 per person before November 1.



Pre-Season Leagues in Dec at Buck Hill & Wild Mountain

Get three weeks of league racing before the season even starts! The December leagues Wednesdays at Wild Mountain and Wednesdays and Thursdays at Buck Hill will run for three Wednesdays starting December 5.

These leagues run similar to our regular league series. A team format will be used. Individual awards will also be given out each week. All scores will be sent in to NASTAR.

Cost to join is \$35 for the three weeks. This is a great opportunity to bring out some friends who may be interested in trying it out.

Guest Racing

If you are interested in just trying it out, you can guest race one time at any of our league races for \$10. You will receive a medal and your scores will be sent in to NASTAR. If you decided to join, your \$10 will go toward your league fees.
